"... are publicly available materials that are either a part of or a complete course usually from a higher-education institution such as a university or college."






OER

 150.6 million tertiary students globally in 2007, 53% increase over 2000




A fancy form of plagiarism

- Prepare for teaching = PRIVATE







- Teaching (transform & extend knowledge)




